<u>JOB SUMMARY</u>: This individual is responsible for general installation and repair duties related to electronic communications equipment. Will report to the Deputy Director or Director of Emergency Services.

General Requirements:

- Essential personnel subject to emergency call-back with little or no notice
- May be required to workday or evening shift, or weekends as required.
- Possession of a valid driver's license, and a motor vehicle history with less than 4 points

Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Installs communications and other electronic equipment in vehicles and buildings
- Performs basic first level troubleshooting of communications and other electronic equipment
- Performs basic preventative maintenance tasks on vehicles, tools, and equipment
- Performs basic fabrication of metal components to support equipment installation
- Assists with basic programming of subscriber communications equipment
- Performs low voltage wiring and the installation and repair of low voltage appliances
- Performs bonding and grounding including the employment of exothermic welding
- Operates and maintains a variety of hand tools, power tools and test equipment
- · Recommends material and supply inventory as required
- Responsible for the completion of documentation related to work performed
- Assists with maintenance of radio system infrastructure
- Supports the Worcester County Land Mobile Radio Support Team and assists with emergency response activities as required and directed
- Wears Personal Protective Equipment as required from time to time
- Completes assigned tasks accurately and by established deadlines
- Cross train and back up other staff as needed
- Establishes and maintains harmonious working relationships with co-workers, elected or appointed officials, and the general public using tact, discretion, sound judgment, and professionalism
- Complies with safety programs, procedures training, fire drills, COOP plans, etc. and works safely
- Ensures confidentiality of information and records and complies with record retention schedule

- Performs other related duties as required by the Director or Deputy Director of the department

Qualifications and Skills:

- Must have a basic understanding of automotive and low voltage circuits.
- Experience related to installing 2-way radio equipment, automotive electronics, marine electronics, public safety warning devices, security systems or network infrastructure
- Must be able to work shift work, weekends and holidays
- Employees with this job title are designated as Emergency/Essential and may be required with little or no notice to work
- Obtain EVT Certification for L1 (Law Enforcement Vehicle Installation Technician) within 18 months of employment
